

### Analysis of the Students' Satisfaction Survey

Student's satisfaction survey was done with the help of a feedback form at the end of the academic year. The analysis of the feedback process indicates a sense of satisfaction in majority of the students towards the syllabus, course and curriculum of the program, extent of the syllabus covered and the teacher's approach towards teaching in the class rooms. Majority of the students believe that teacher's attitude towards extra-curricular activities is satisfactory and they inform them about the expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes. Majority of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc. while teaching. Majority of the students feel satisfied with the available sports facilities and opportunities in the college. After their graduation most of the students want to go for higher studies while others want to prepare for competitive exams and few of them want to join the job in the market. The survey points towards the need of improvement on certain areas like proper and uninterrupted internet connectivity, better facilities and improvement in the condition of reading area in the library and separate common rooms for boys and girls. Along with this the students also expected for and improvement in cleanliness of toilets and washrooms in the campus.
